NEW ASSOCIATE VP FOR HR ANNOUNCED

Illinois State University is pleased to announce the appointment, effective June 1, 2004 of Ira Schoenwald, Ph.D. as the new associate vice president for Human Resources. Dr. Schoenwald



was the associate vice president for faculty affairs and academic resources at California State University (CSU) Channel Islands. Dr. Schoenwald comes to ISU with over 28 years of experience as a faculty, department chair and academic administrator at CSU Dominguez Hills and CSU Channel Islands.

Dr. Schoenwald received his Ph.D. in government from the Claremont

Graduate School in 1979. He joined CSU Dominguez Hills as a faculty member and later served as department chair for both the health sciences and public administration departments there. He also spent 10 years as an academic administrator at CSU Dominguez Hills. During this time he held several positions including director of university personnel, assistant to the president and most recently associate vice president for faculty affairs. In 1999, Dr. Schoenwald was tapped to help establish and build CSU's Channel Islands campus from scratch.

Dr. Schoenwald will complete the merger and consolidation of the various human resources functions on campus, provide leadership in implementing the goals of augmenting the Human Resources office support for faculty and staff recruitment, retention, and development, oversee the University's labor management program, and contribute to the overall University policy development.

UNIVERSITY POLICIES / PROCEDURES

5.2.2 REPORTING OF CRIMES IN PROGRESS, FIRE AND MEDICAL EMERGENCIES (www.policy.ilstu.edu)

Dial 9-1-1 to notify the police immediately of crimes that are in progress (that is, crimes which are occurring at the same time you are notifying the police,) or when there is fire, smoke, or a medical emergency.

Your call will be answered by a 9-1-1 dispatcher at the Illinois State University Police Department. Be prepared to provide the following information to the 9-1-1 dispatcher: Your name, a phone number where you can be reached for call back purposes, the nature of the emergency, crime in progress, fire, or medical emergency, and the location of emergency.

Stay on the phone with the 9-1-1 dispatcher until you are told that you may hang up. The dispatcher will gain enough information initially to dispatch the appropriate agencies and will then come back and ask you for additional information.
