## EMPLOYEE ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVE ELECTION

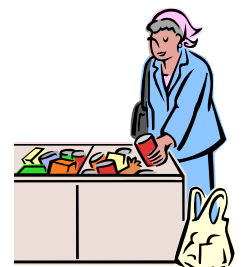
