Better Representation for Civil Service

The Civil Service population on campus is divided into five constituency groups. The purpose of the groups is to allow for better representation on the Council for all Civil Service employees at Illinois State. Over the past several years an increasing gap in the size of these groups has occurred. For example, Group Two is currently made up of approximately 100 employees, while there are approximately 500 employees in Group Five. This means the three members elected for group two represent far fewer people than the three elected to represent group five.

Last summer the executive board of the Council began discussions with Human Resources in order to divide the constituency groups more equally. During our discussions it was determined that the guidelines established to place employees in a constituency group were far outdated resulting in the large gaps. After several meetings with Human Resources and discussions with the Council, the determination of constituency groups based on employee job codes was voted on and approved during the February 4 meeting. In order to avoid confusion during the 2014 elections, the Council waited until fall 2014 to adopt the changes.

As of September 15 all Civil Service employees will be divided into five constituency groups based on their job code. Below is a list of job codes, split into the five groups. For a list of job codes with the associated descriptions, please visit CSCouncil.IllinoisState.edu/Elections. As a result of the re-structuring, some employees' group numbers will change. The group numbers only relate to Council elections for representation and do not affect job codes or classifications.

There will be a few current Council members who will change groups as a result of the new division. A change in groups is already addressed within the Council By-Laws Article IV, Section 2:

If a Council member's Civil Service appointment changes to another constituency group during his/her term of office due to reclassification, transfer, or promotion, that Council member's status on the Council will remain unchanged.

This means all current Council members will fulfill their elected terms in the group they were elected to represent. Once their terms end, they may run again for their current constituency group. If you have any questions about the updates to the constituency groups, please contact:

Campus Dining Services would like to remind faculty and staff of a change that was originally announced in spring 2014.

Beginning Wednesday, August 13, 2014, Campus Dining Services will only accept flex dollars, Redbird Dollars, and credit/debit cards at the dining centers, Jamba Juice in the Student Fitness Center, the Business Bistro in the State Farm Hall of Business, Airport Lounge in Centennial, and Einstein Bros Bagels at Milner Library. Cash will no longer be accepted those locations. All locations within the Bone Student Center as well as Subway restaurants in residential areas will continue to accept cash.
