RE CCGR Future Agenda

Attached you will find a report on the progress that CCGR has made toward fulfilling its original charge of January, 1972. The report presents the outline of a new model which we think would improve the quality of governance at ISU. While we are fully cognizant that there are difficulties involved with this new model, we feel that it will maximize more of the goals we have been given than does the present system.

We are hereby requesting clarification on the nature of our next task. Specifically we request that you: 1) Approve the general governance model and direct us to develop the specific wording necessary to implement it, 2) indicate what changes you desire us to make in the governance model before we begin to develop the implementation wording, or 3) determine that no changes in the present system are desired at this time.

Please feel free to call upon us for any explanations concerning the operation of the model or the rationale for any specific aspect of it.
