APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Miss Russell moved that the minutes of the meeting of May 17 be approved. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gimmestad and passed.

DEPARTMENT PROCEDURE REPORT

On Monday, May 29, Mr. Dalluge, Chairman of the University Council, requested a special meeting of the council to discuss certain proposed University policies which some of the council members had brought to his attention. The meeting was called at 11:45 on Thursday, June 1.

The Chairman felt that the group should discuss the action of the last meeting inasmuch as there had been some misunderstanding on the part of some of the faculty members as well as some of the council members concerning the report of the Committee to Study Departmental Procedure.

Mr. Dalluge further stated that only this morning he had received a communication from a group of staff members asking that the council reconsider certain portions of the report mentioned above. After considerable discussion it was felt this report should be further studied and perhaps modified before being put into effect. Mr. Helgeson made the following motion which was seconded by President Bone;

While accepting the report of the Committee to Study Departmental Procedures, the University Council postpones the official adoption of the report for further study and the consideration of additional reactions from the faculty.

The motion carried.
