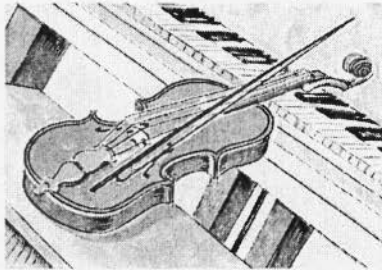

Dr. Glenn Block – Dr. Block is the director of orchestras and opera at Illinois State University. An active guest conductor, he is one of the most active all-state orchestra conductors, having conducted in more than 42 states, Canada, South America, and throughout Europe. He serves as music director of the Youth Symphony of Kansas City, one of the country's largest and most extensive youth symphony programs, which was invited by MENC to be the broadcast orchestra for the 1995 World's Largest Concert and which performed at the opening concerts of the 1996 National Conference. In addition, the Youth Symphony was one of only six youth orchestras from throughout the world invited to the Banff (Canada) International Festival of Youth Orchestras in April 1996. Dr. Block is also the music director of the Sangamon Valley Youth Symphony in Springfield, Illinois.

Brian Dollinger - Mr. Dollinger is in his final year of study towards a Master's Degree in Orchestral Conducting at Illinois State University. He received his Bachelor of Music in Double Bass Performance in 1994 from Illinois State University. He has also studied at the University of North Texas and returned to Illinois State University to complete his current degree with Dr. Block. Mr. Dollinger has been a guest conductor with the Central Illinois Concert Orchestra and the Sangamon Valley Youth Symphony. He is the new conductor for the Dunlap, Illinois string program. Mr. Dollinger plans to begin his work towards a doctoral degree next year.
