About the Composers:

Sergei Rachmaninoff

The third movement in the *Vespers, or All-Night Vigil*, published in 1915. After a century and a half of Italian and then German influences, from the end of the 19th century there was an attempt to return to the original sources of Russian Church chanting. The notion of liturgical music was going through a change from a social point of view at this period, tending more and more to go beyond the framework of the church, more intended for concert settings.

Blessed is the man,
who walks not in the counsel of the wicked. Alleluia.
