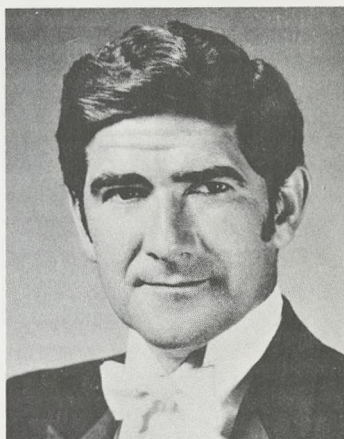

GUEST CLINICIANS

Dr. Don V. Moses is Chairman of the Choral Department at the University of Iowa. Dr. Moses received his undergraduate degree from Fort Hays Kansas State College and both the Master of Music and Doctor of Music degrees from Indiana University in 1963 and 1968. He has served as music instructor at Hays High School and assistant professor of music at Indiana University, where he conducted the University Chamber Singers. At the University of Iowa, Dr. Moses founded the Iowa "Kantorei," an ensemble of 30 singers representing the University on tours and in concerts throughout the United States. Dr. Moses will head the choral department of the Revelli International School of Music in Glion-Montreux, Switzerland, in the summer of 1974.



Dr. John W. Ferrell, professor of music at Illinois State University, has directed the University Madrigal Singers since 1962, during which time that group has gained a national and international reputation for excellence, appearing at two European festivals in 1972 and 1973, and several important American conventions of scholarly musical organizations. Dr. Ferrell received the undergraduate degree in music education from Iowa Wesleyan University and both the Masters and Doctors degrees in music education from the University of Iowa. In addition to conducting the Madrigal Singers, Dr. Ferrell also conducts the University-Community Oratorio Choir, and teaches undergraduate and graduate music education.
