curiam opinion.

The opinion simply affirms on the basis
of the Salyer decision. As I ~~was~~ mentioned in
the bench memo, I am a little bothered by the
lack of information about the watershed district
here involved. We don't know much about
the interests of residents in the affairs of
the district, nor does the population of the
district appear. Still, all indications are
that the district is essentially similar to
that in Salyer.
